

Checklist for Homeschool Reporting Requirements in Minnesota

Notify the District:



File a report with our school district superintendent to notify them of your intentions. This can be done by letter or prepared form from an organization you trust.

When: By October 1 each year.



UNLESS you are removing your child from public school then it must be within 15 days of removing them and then by October 1 for subsequent years.

In addition, if you've moved OUT of a district you must notify them within 15 days and notify the NEW school district by October 1.

Who: Any child between the ages of 7 and 17



EXCEPT If you're are withdrawing your child from public school and they are younger than 7 you will still need to file this report.

If your child is between 16 and 17 and this is the FIRST year you will homeschool, you must also report your student to the school district.

What Information to Include:



- Names, birth dates and addresses of children who will be homeschooled
- Immunization record included on initial form or if your student has reached age 12. You can attach a notarized statement of conscientiously held beliefs statement for exemption on this requirement.
- The name of the standardized test you will be using along with the administrator and location.
